

List of Accomplishments the Past 10 Years

The following is a list of some of the more notable accomplishments achieved by the Falaise Community Association over the past 10 years. We acknowledge that many of these achievements have been possible through cooperation and the work of Saanich municipality and residents.

Undertook Highway Beautification project; planting a screen of trees beside Pat Bay Highway. Resident -Only parking sign posted on Falaise Crescent in response to heavy use by Broadmead Centre employees.

Signage at Falaise Drive and Falaise Crescent corner improved to reduce confusion about highway access and funeral home locations.

Traffic light sequencing improvements Royal Oak Drive /Falaise Drive corner.

Sidewalks at Falaise Drive and Royal Oak lights widened to better accommodate mobility-impaired pedestrians (i.e. with walkers and scooters)

Pathway joining Falaise Drive to Royal Oak Drive installed by Saanich

Hosted the Tree Love Town Hall, an event to support the Saanich Urban Forest Strategy

Falaise Park:

- New playground erected and now extremely popular with families
- Arranged installation of larger 30 km/hr Speed Limit signs
- Split rail cedar fence installed beside roadside for safety
- The park has become a focus location for holding community events
- Memorial Plaques commemorating the establishment and history of the Falaise community installed at park entrance.
- Picnic table beside playground installed
- New park bench installed with commemorative plaque
- Park Pulling Together Volunteer Committee established for maintaining the park

Started Annual Community Garage Sale which has become an iconic event

Annual Neighbourhood Picnic held each summer for past 10 years

Hosted Family Day celebration event -fun and games for Falaise families

Continued publishing Falaise Focus newsletter; keeping residents informed of news and activities in the community

FCA website established and FCA Facebook Page set up

Revised the FCA Constitution to be consistent with BC Societies Act.

Maintained communication with Saanich municipality - Mayor and Council

Opened communication with Provincial MLA office Lana Popham
