Policy Regarding Input on Neighbouring Community Issues

Date: July 14 2021

Rationale:

This policy has been created to clarify when it is deemed appropriate for the FCA to become involved in issues within the wider Saanich community.

Policy Statement:

1. The FCA shall always advocate for the best interests of the Falaise community.
2. If an issue surfaces within the greater community (municipal or provincial) that could potentially affect the FCA community:
 - a) Directors will discuss implications for the Falaise community and vote on if they feel that there could be a significant impact on residents' quality of life. If it is deemed to not affect the community, the issue will not proceed further.
 - b) If the issue is deemed to affect the Falaise community, the Directors will seek input and guidance from the membership. The members will be contacted via email and/or other means.
 - c) A vote will be taken by the Board (after community input) with majority determining future course of action.
3. If an issue surfaces within the greater community (municipal or provincial) and it does not affect the Falaise community, the FCA will not comment.
