#### Financial Report: Carl

- 1. There is a healthy balance in our bank account at present (\$5,249)
  - a) Directors should speak with community members and solicit input on possible wish list items.
  - b) Directors to bring ideas to our April meeting.

Financial report dated March 7, 2022, was submitted for approval. There were 133 paid members as of March 7<sup>th</sup>. There have been 35 since then that will be included in the report next month.

## **SCAN report:** Mac

- 1. Acting Saanich CAO Brent Reems attended with the mayor. The mayor spoke on items 2-4.
- Saanich future area plans include a move toward densification of highway corridors and community centres. These plans are posted on the Saanich website. It means existing LAPs would not be updated.

- 3. Saanich is moving toward a Consent Agenda model. Less controversial items will be first up and any requiring more input will be put further down on the agenda.
- 4. Saanich currently holds 12 public hearings per year. They are hoping to condense public hearings for three years of development requests into one year to clear up the backlog. It is with the proviso that each application has met all Saanich planning requirements. This will result in minimal public consultations.

## **Committee reports / actions:**

- 1. Noise Wall (Stew)
  - a) We may still be able to access some funds from the New Canada Building Fund. Stew and Stuart will discuss with Mayor Haynes and the acting CAO (Brent Reems) at the March 21<sup>st</sup> meeting.
- 2. Membership Drive 2022 (Mac)
  - a) Membership drive is going well. There are 168 residents signed up to date.
- 3. Falaise Park Inspection Report (Stuart)
  - a) The park inspection was cancelled and will be rescheduled.

#### **Old Business**

- 1. Afghanistan refugee sponsorship program
  - a) Marlene Simmons has a group that is prepared to move forward on this individual residents' project.
- 2. Falaise Drive road mural project motion to approve
  - a) We have received the grant from Saanich.
  - b) The additional required insurance for the dates of the road painting is included in the budget. No additional funding required.
  - c) Next steps: complete a draft design and canvas remaining immediate neighbours for concept approval

Motion: Move that the FCA approve the road mural project and agree to move forward with the plan outlined in the grant.

- 3. Falaise Drive / Royalwood Place intersection safety issue
  - a) There are continuing concerns regarding the safety of the left-hand turn from Royalwood Place onto Falaise Drive.
  - b) The resident owning the property bordering the curve has agreed to cut down a bush that obscures the line of sight.
  - c) SLOW DOWN signs have been purchased with the intention of posting them on the Saanich right-of-way on either side of the curve.
- 4. Community survey
  - a) Limesurvey will be used as in 2021.

- b) A committee has been formed to update relevant questions to reflect current issues: Bob, Stuart, Barb.
- c) The draft survey will be submitted to the directors for approval prior to sending it out.
- d) The committee will complete a draft by April and have the final draft ready for circulation by early May
- e) One item to include: community input into having local businesses advertise in the FF.

#### **New Business**

- 1. Invitation to speak with the Mayor Haynes and CAO Brent Reems.
  - a) The meeting will take place on March 21<sup>st</sup>. Format is to discuss positive and negative issues associated with Saanich residency.
  - b) Stew and Stuart will attend
- 2. Invitation to meet with BARA, FCA, and Royal Oak BIA
  - a) Stuart to contact the president of BARA to discuss potential topics
  - b) Mayor has requested one participant from each association
  - c) Date and location TBA

  - a) Our account is not set up as a community board but rather as a communication tool for our association and its events. It was suggested that the resident look into Next*Door* which is an app set up as a community forum.

  - b) The plan's premise is that if consumption is reduced, the planet can sustain itself. This action group is tasked with brainstorming ways for communities to exist in sustainable ways.
