### Committee reports / actions:

- 1. Noise Wall (Stew)
  - a) Stew will continue to follow up. Saanich staff and highways staff are working out parameters for their responsibilities. Current proposal is to fill in ditch and put noise wall sections in lower areas.
- 2. Membership 2022 (Mac)
  - a) 229 current. Two homes have recently sold, 9636and 9653 Falaise Drive. Mac will welcome new residents when they have moved in.
- 3. SCAN (Mac)
  - a) The September meeting will be held tomorrow night. Mac will attend and report next month

#### **Old Business**

- 1. Falaise Park second picnic table meeting
  - a) Stuart met with Diane Murray. Saanich Parks is willing to move the request forward but do not anticipate that any further action will begin before the new year. We expect a confirmation letter from the Parks director.
- 2. Road Mural Paint Day report Stuart
  - a) This was a successful project with strong community support (45 adults, 20 children).
  - b) "Thank you" letters have been sent out to organizers and volunteers.
  - c) Stuart will take monthly photos to monitor the wear of the road mural.
  - d) Saanich police have been contacted to set up a speed reader. The results will be compared to previous speed results.
- 3. Community Survey preliminary results (Bob)
  - a) People are happy with what the FCA is doing (activities and projects) but do not want to become actively involved.
  - b) There was strong support for allowing local businesses to advertise in the Falaise Focus. Consider offering this service for next newsletter (too late for the Fall issue).
  - c) Bob to write a one-page summary for the website and a recap for publication in the Falaise Focus.
- 4. Verge parking beside the playground (Mac)
  - a) Stuart wrote an initial letter in 2021 to Saanich but no action taken to date. Mac will take this on and reinitiate contact as it fits with his road safety project.
  - b) Slow Down sign Mac feels that it is too close to the edge of the pavement. Risk is low but it can be moved further in and still be visible. Stuart and Bob will move it so that the pole aligns with the pole on the slow down sign. Another sign can also be added closer to the bend approaching the park.
